## *Challenging Attitudes of Young Drivers at Risk*

Rare View will provide an opportunity for young people in out-of-home care and other vulnerable young people to participate in a tailored driver attitude and education program, with a practical focus on defensive skills. In partnership with *Motorvate* this program will comprise of interactive discussions and practical skills including: how to avoid emergencies and how to control life-threatening situations, including skid control. The young people will gain life-saving information from real experts, and be more aware of their own skills and attitude. *Motorvate* will show how their driving can be safe *and* fun. The practical sessions will teach invaluable lessons about excessive speed, stopping distances and how quickly emergencies can develop.
